




Licence to use the demo version of

POLPRED

POLPRED for Windows is available for demonstration and evaluation purposes. Before you can use the software, you need to obtain a configuration file and a licence file which when copied into the installation directory, will unlock the program for the demonstration period and area. To obtain these files, print out this document, sign it to state you agree with the terms and conditions of use and fax (0151 795 4905) or e-mail it back to NOC (email: dataproducts@noc.ac.uk).

Please read the following notes about the demo version of POLPRED for Windows:

- The program will not work until you have signed this licence and received the configuration file and licence file to 'unlock' the software.
 These files can be sent to you either by e-mail or by post on floppy disk.
- The demo licence will permit the software to make computations for the month of September 2000 and for the area shown right. This should be sufficient for evaluation of the software.
- It uses data that has since been superseded by a much more accurate data set used in the full version of the program.
- The program and any output from the program must not be used for any commercial or research purpose. Contact the National Oceanography Centre (dataproducts@noc.ac.uk) for details on purchasing the software.
- Technical support for the demo version of POLPRED is limited to problems encountered during installation only.
